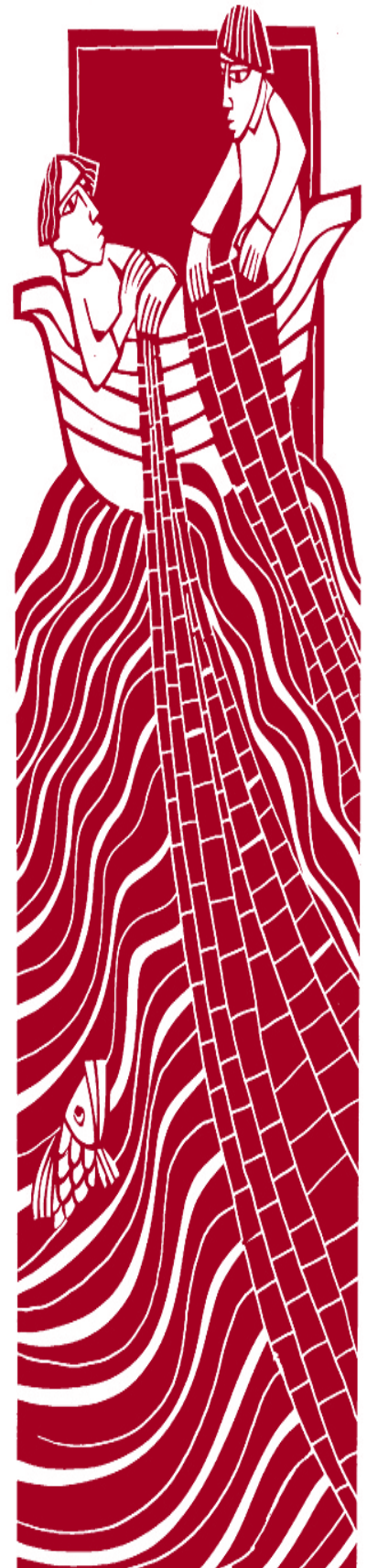

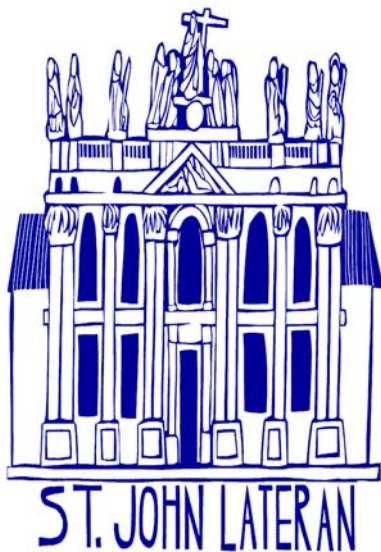

The Year of Mark

The year of St Mark begins in the lectionary from the first Sunday of Advent this year to the same time next year. Many of the Sundays follow this Gospel. Mark's main interest is the person of Jesus. He follows Jesus through his public ministry in Galilee and outside Galilee and finally to Jerusalem before the Passion. The crisis is reached when the fundamental question is posed to the disciples: 'Who do you say that I am?' Peter's confession of faith is at the heart of Mark's Gospel. In the year of Mark the Gospel sticks to his structure of and message with the exception of a major insert from St John's Gospel in which Jesus reveals himself as the Bread of Life.

Structure of the Year of Mark

The following is the sequence of readings that covers the main parts of the Gospel of St Mark during the next year

Unit I

The figure of the Messiah Sundays 1-2

Unit II

The mystery progressively revealed Sunday 3-23

Stage I Jesus with the Jewish crowds **Sundays 3-9**

Stage 2 Jesus with the disciples **Sundays 10-14**

Stage 3 Jesus manifests himself **Sundays 15-23**

Unit III

The mystery of the Son of Man Sundays 24-34

Stage I The way of the Son of Man **Sundays 24-30**

Stage 2 Final revelation at Jerusalem **Sundays 31-33**

Stage 3 The fulfilment of the mystery **Sunday 34**
