In 8 years as parish priest I have always emphasised the importance of caring for the poor and needy, that remains a priority, in fact over this period we have never stopped fundraising for charities! The planned work is of general improvement and renovation of the building, a work in which we seek to make the church a place fit for worship of God. Payment for the windows will be taken from our reserves and those who can **afford** and **wish** to, are asked to put extra in the collections each week. New envelopes will be given on request. Some people have suggested that the see-through glass would take away from the privacy of the church. In the light of these comments I have asked that one be fitted so that we might see what it looks like.
