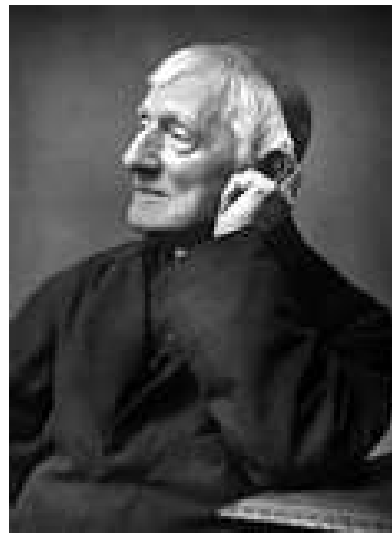
Cardinal Newman

Father John Henry Newman was formally received into the Catholic Church in October 1845. In the following year he went to Rome and was ordained a Catholic priest. Upon returning to England as a member of the Oratorian order, the newly ordained priest took up various teaching posts in schools, eventually arriving at Edgbaston, near Birmingham. He would spend the next 40 years living in seclusion in this place. Father Newman taught at the Oratory School in Reading, which was regarded to be the best Catholic school in England. He also helped establish the Oratory in London and gave a series of lectures on Catholicism in England.

In 1845, at the request of the Catholic Bishops in Ireland, Father Newman travelled to Ireland as the Rector of the newly established Catholic University of Ireland, where he delivered a series of lectures entitled, *The Idea of a University*. During this time he also published, *Grammar of Assent*, in which he attempted to defend religion as a legitimate activity that was not contrary to human nature.

In 1878, Fr Newman was made an honorary Fellow of the University of Oxford. At this same time Pope Leo XIII made him a Cardinal of the Church, unusual because he wasn't a bishop. He continued to write and publish in the later years of his life.

Newman died on August 11 1890 and was buried at Rednal cemetery near the Birmingham Oratory. He will be beatified by Pope Benedict in Coventry in September 2010.
