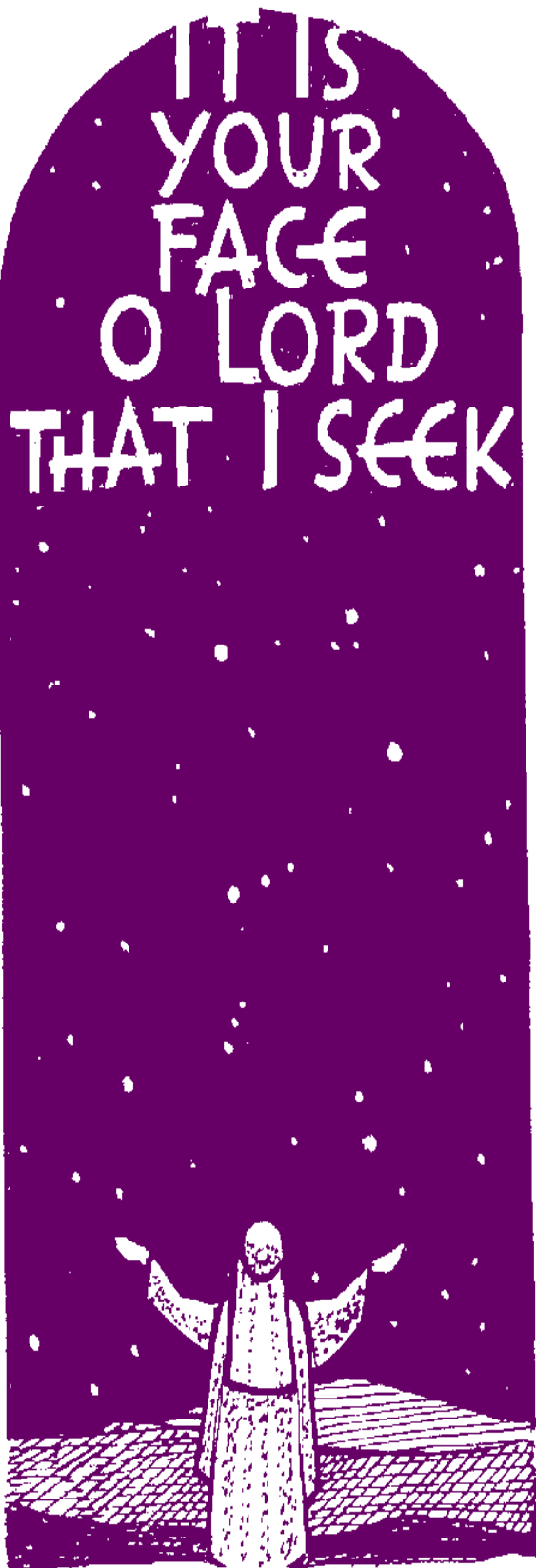


St Bride's - Parish Bulletin
