## **Improving our celebration of the Liturgy**

Here are things that I would suggest are areas that could improve our celebration of the Mass:

- Maintaining quietness before and after Mass.
- Singing the hymns and parts of the Mass.
- To learn new things that make for a fitting celebration of the Mass.
- To volunteer our God-given talents for the service of others.
- Speaking clearly and thoughtfully the responses of Mass, neither rushing them or making them excessively slow.
- Being aware of particularly important part of the Mass.
- Coming with a desire to participate, to receive and to leave with a deeper faith.
- A commitment to belong to and share as a parish in the celebration of the Mass and where all in the parish community walk together.
- Not to turn up late or leave early from the Mass.
- A personal commitment to live a life of faith & charity that we celebrate in the Mass.
