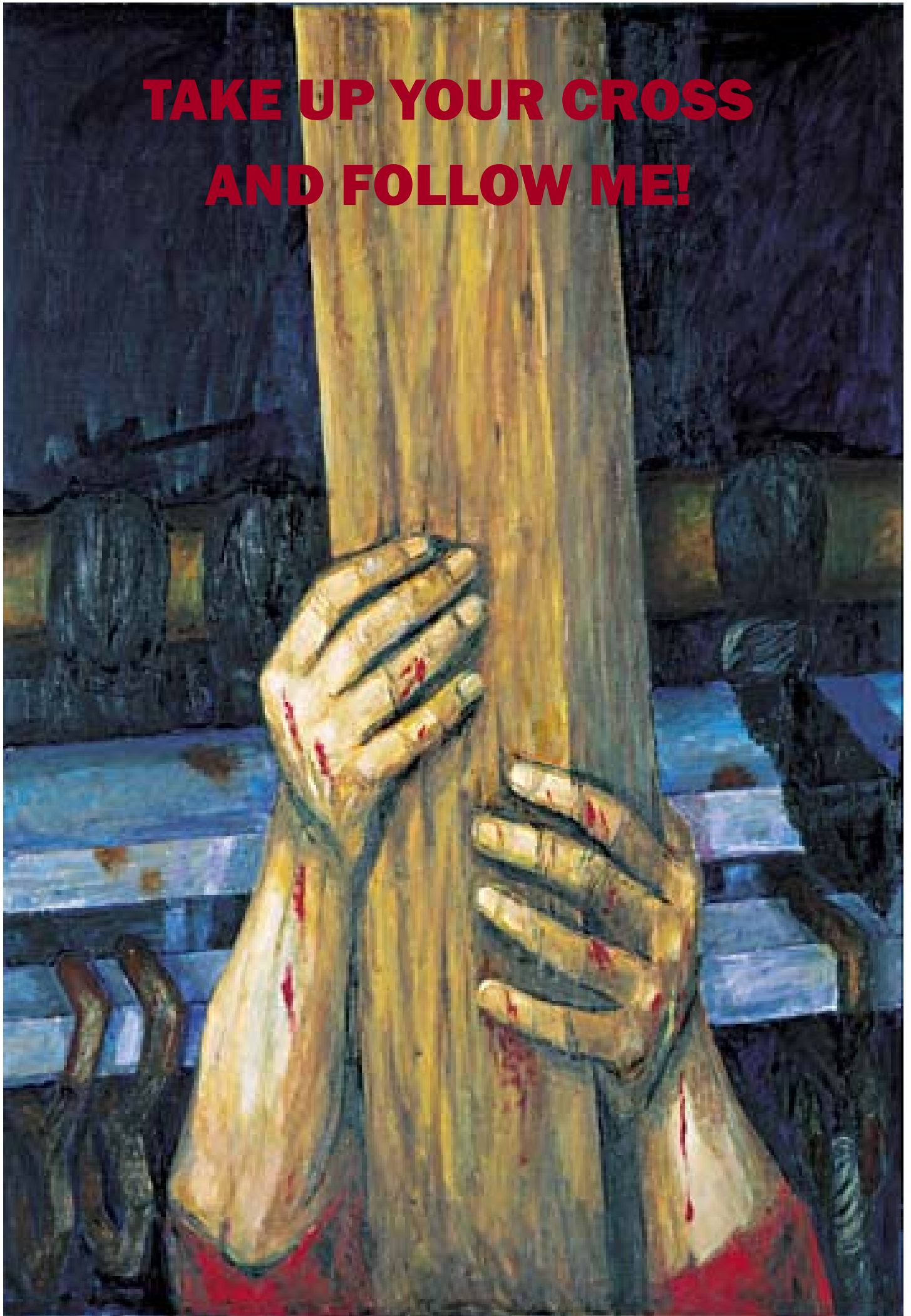


**TAKE UP YOUR CROSS
