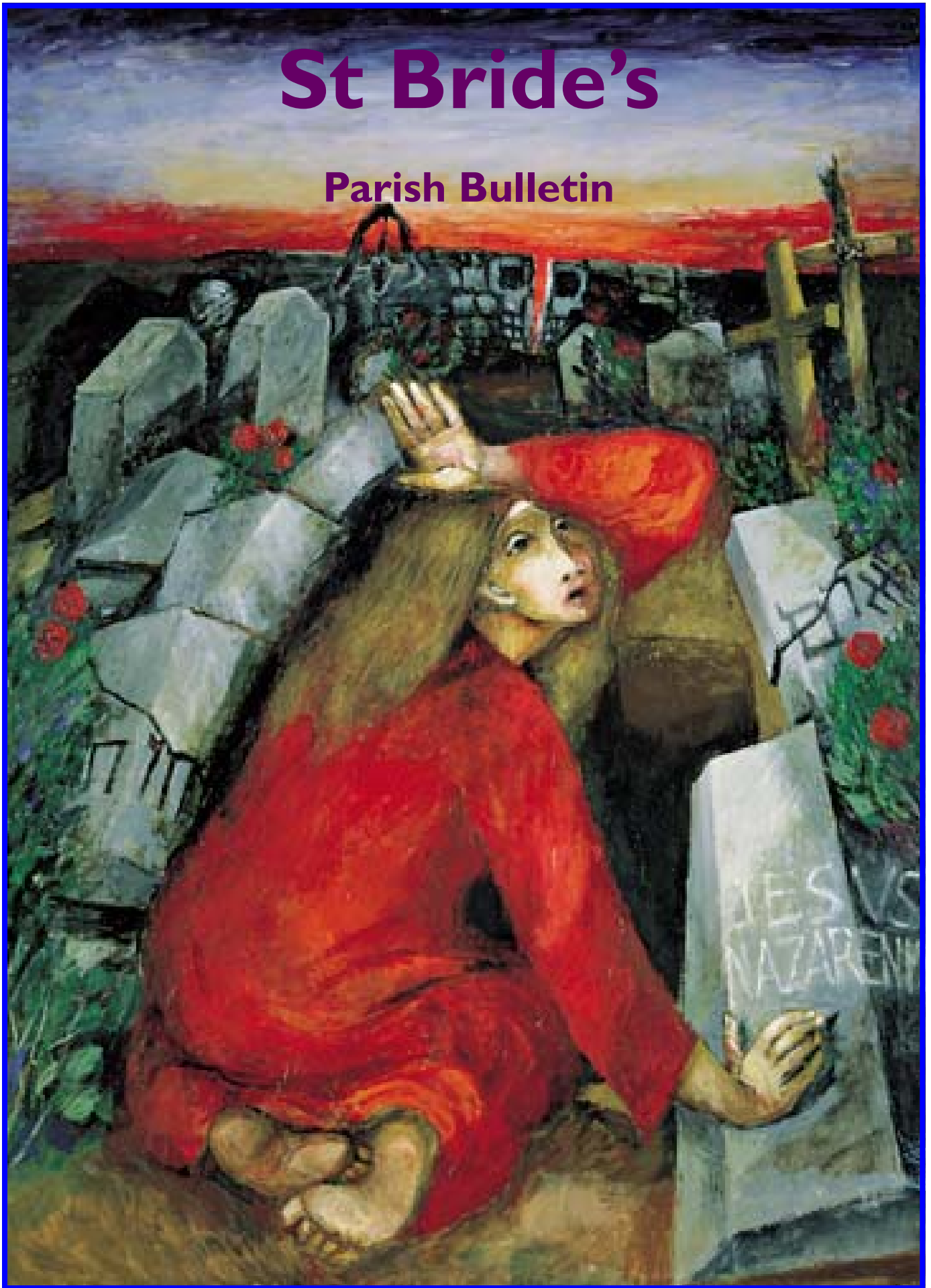


We are looking again at plans for the Bell tower in the church. More information to follow.
