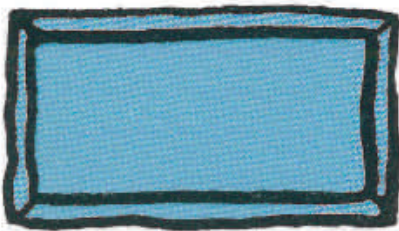

Day Away

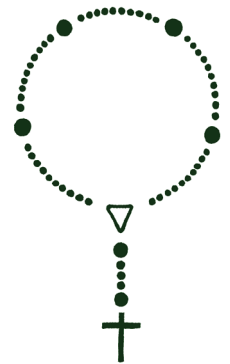
We are planning a day away to Ayr on 3rd August. Put your name down, if you would like to come.

Interested in joining the parish in late July for the pilgrimage to Lourdes? Please put your name down on the sheet.

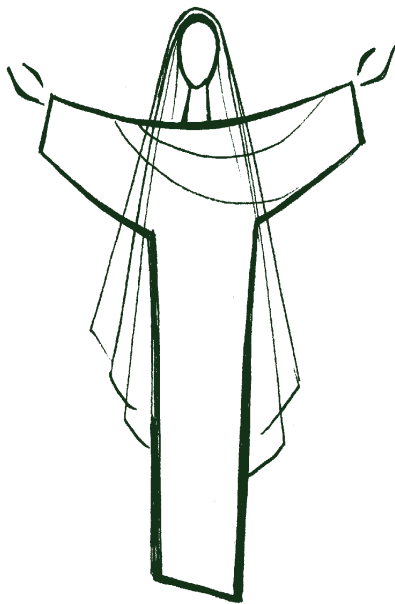


DVDs
