There will be a parish pilgrimage to Fatima in October 2011. If you are interested, please put your name down at the back of the church.

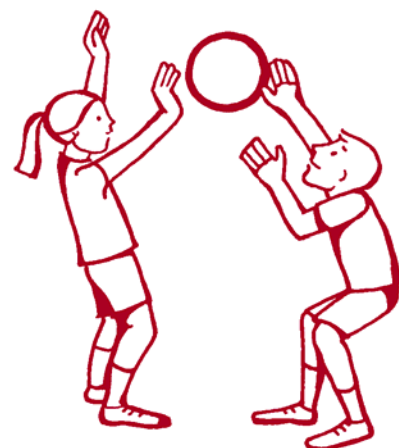
