### **Day Away**

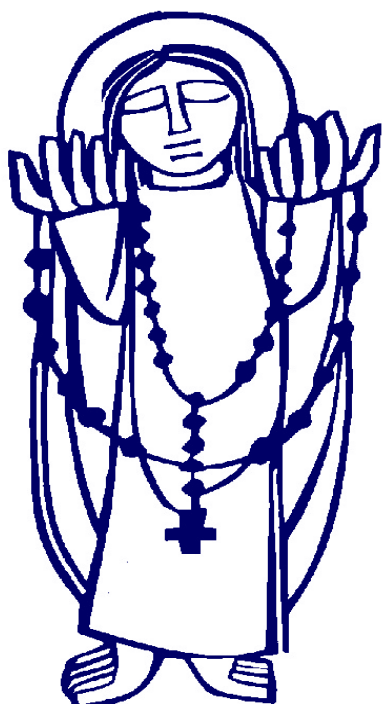
Thanks to everyone who came on the parish day away to Ayr - a great day was had by all.
