## Year of Luke

*St Luke was a gentile who was also believed to be a doctor (St Paul's letter to the Colossians). His Gospel is written to Theophilus, a serious enquirer about the life of Jesus. Luke's Gospel is written in clear Greek and with access to careful research and also with the help of his companion, St Paul. Luke is writing for Gentiles and consequently gives explanations of places and rituals in the Jewish faith. He has many themes which include: prayer, the importance of women, care for the poor and the Gospel being for all and not for the few. In his Gospel he sets out the love of God that has come through Jesus and recounts some of the most wonderful parables of Jesus: the Prodigal Son, the Good Samaritan etc*

*At the beginning of Advent, we begin Year C. The main Gospel during this year is Luke's.*
